

LGBTI+ Terminology Worksheet

LGBTI+	Bullying based on prejudice or discrimination towards LGBTI+ people.
Gender identity	People whose gender identity is not exclusively male or female
Bisexual	Someone who is not transgender or non-binary.
Transgender	Someone who is mainly attracted to people of the same gender.
Lesbian	Someone who is a friend, advocate, and/or activist for LGBTI people
LGBTI+ Bullying	Our deeply felt internal experience of our own gender.
Heterosexual	How we show our gender through our clothing, hair, behaviour, etc.
Intersex	Someone who is attracted to people of a different gender.
Gay	Sexual and romantic attraction.
Ally	Someone who could be attracted to any person, regardless of their gender.
Gender Expression	A woman who is mainly attracted to other women.
Sexual Orientation	People whose gender identity differs from the sex they were given at birth.
Pansexual	Someone who is attracted to more than one gender
Non-binary	Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Trans+ and Intersex people.
Cisgender	People who are born with variations in their sexual anatomy or their hormonal patterns, which are not seen as fitting in with typical male or female bodies.
