Overview

Belong To's vision is for an Ireland where lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer (LGBTQ+) young people are equal, safe, and valued in the diversity of their identities and experiences. We work with LGBTQ+ young people as equals to achieve our vision through youth work, changing attitudes, and research.

The Role of an Events Volunteer

The role of our Events Volunteers is to support the Belong To team at community and fundraising events.

- Represent Belong To at events with community groups, schools and workplaces.
- Signpost event attendees to relevant Belong To staff members and resources.
- Raise awareness of Belong To and Belong To's services.
- Support the fundraising team with bucket fundraising on the street, at community events and at gigs.

- Share and utilise your valuable skills and expertise, and learn new skills.
- Belong To's volunteers are part of the team and will be invited to many of our events throughout the year.

Time Commitment

Up to 20 hours over the course of a year.

Experience and Person Specification

Volunteers with Belong To must share our vision of an Ireland where all LGBTQ+ young people are equal, safe and valued in the diversity of their identities and experiences.

Volunteers must:

- be enthusiastic and approachable
- be responsible
- have strong communication skills
- be inclusive to all LGBTQ+ identities

Process for Recruiting Events Volunteers

- 1. Expressions of Interest are received through our website.
- 2. A staff member will follow up with an enquiry call to explain more about the role and explore suitability.
- 3. Events volunteers will complete our new volunteer form to provide their contact details, emergency contact details and any relevant medical/dietary information to allow them to participate fully.
- 4. New events volunteers will attend an induction training session to learn about Belong To and their roles.
- 5. New events volunteers will complete a 1-hour online child safeguarding training and a 1-hour online LGBTQ+ inclusivity training in their own time. They will provide their certificates to Belong To.
- 6. Events volunteers will sign a volunteer agreement.

Other Information

Eligibility.

Events volunteers must be over 18 years old. They must be available to volunteer in person in the Republic of Ireland.

Health Checks

Volunteers may be required to complete a medical check and be certified as fit to perform the duties of the role at the discretion of Belong To. The cost of any medical checks will be borne by Belong To.
